He was chairman of the Miami Democratic Party, Right to Life, American Legion, Jaycees, and S.P.E.B.S.Q.S.A. Of Miami Valley.

**Ed Jackson** also was a member since 1961 and served as District Deputy for several years when the Council was in the "Ohio Top Ten" for four years.

Ed devoted his energy and his love to his family, his Church, and his country. He served during World War II, wounded twice, was shot down over Yugoslavia, and managed to escape. He received the Distinguished Flying Cross, two Purple Hearts, the Air Medal, and other awards.
